CO-ED LEAGUE

- 1, 2 or 3 divisions
- Format: 10 games/9-10 weeks
- 1:30 game time limit
- Sunday games only; times range from 9:00 am-4:30 pm
- League starts 4/27/25
- Game dates: 4/27, 5/4, 5/11, 5/18, 6/1, 6/8, 6/15, 6/22, 6/29
- No game 5/25 & 7/6 (Memorial Day & 4th of July unless needed)
- Make-up games/playoffs will begin 7/13, 7/20, & 7/27 (if necessary).
- All teams qualify for year-end playoff tournament.

ROSTERS

Limit of 18 players per team. Players' addresses and phone numbers must be included. Players may be added or dropped up to the third scheduled games. All 2025 teams need to submit a new roster.

CAPTAINS' MEETING

All teams must have a team representative at the meeting to review and discuss rules and by-laws. League will email date of meeting to all captains once teams are set.

INDIVIDUAL PLAYERS

Individuals or couples wishing to participate but are not yet on a team may put their names on the league's free-agent list. The league will email all captains and names of free agents, and players can be claimed on a first-come, first-serve basis. The league cannot guarantee placement.
